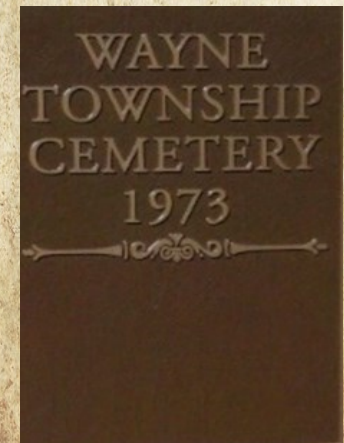
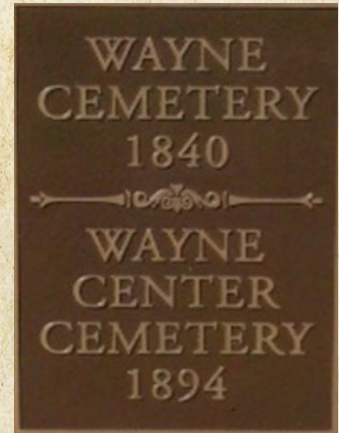

INTERMENTS

- I. No interment or interment service will be permitted on Sundays, legal holidays, religious holidays or state holidays except in the case of religious beliefs.
- II. Wayne Township requires at least 48 hours' notice prior to any interment.
- III. Multiple interments are not allowed in a single grave. The only allowable exception to this rule will be the placing of one cremated remains on top of a full burial or two cremated remains in a lot with no full burial.
- IV. Wayne Township shall not be responsible for the identity of the person to be interred.

MEMORIALS

- I. A sketch of the proposed memorial showing the dimensions and lettering must be reviewed by Wayne Township.
- II. Memorials and monuments may be above ground.. The size is not to exceed 2/3rds the width of the lot(s).
- III. All markers and monuments must align with existing installations.

DECORATIONS

- I. Lot owners shall not be permitted to place benches, chairs, enclosures or like articles on the ground.
- II. The planting of trees, evergreens, rosebushes, perennials or shrubs is not permitted. Wayne Township reserves the right to remove any or all plantings.
- III. All lots shall be seeded by the cemetery. Lot owners wishing sod on their lots must make arrangements with Wayne Township and must pay for same when ordered.
- IV. The following decorations are prohibited: toys, shells, cans, jugs, bottles or freestanding statuary. These articles will be removed if found on graves. Wayne Township reserves the right to remove other decorations not mentioned which pose a hazard to the maintenance of the graves or lots.
- V. Floral pieces, baskets or frames will be removed after a reasonable interval.
- VI. Winter decorations may be placed on graves beginning November 1st and may remain until March 1st. After such date all decorations will be removed.

VISITORS

- I. The cemetery is open from dawn to dusk.
- II. Strangers must keep at a respectful distance during an interment service.
- III. No weapons shall be allowed on the cemetery property.
- IV. No alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on the cemetery property.
- V. Sunbathing, loitering, picnicking or similar activities are forbidden on cemetery property.
- VI. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- VII. Pets will be allowed on the grounds only when leashed and in the presence of their owner. The owner is responsible for cleaning up after their pet and for any damages that pet may cause.
- VIII. Soliciting the sale of any commodity shall not be allowed on the cemetery property. No signs, notices or advertisements of any kind shall be permitted.
