A. FOIA AND OMA Training Requirements for Elected Officials

B. Wayne Township Recycling Event June 7, 2025

Supervisor Ramey reminded the Board of the upcoming Wayne Township recycling event from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. on Saturday, June 7, 2025. The event will allow residents to recycle electronics, batteries, textiles, drop off tattered flags and eveglasses, as well as shred documents. The cost is twenty dollars for TVs and five dollars for microwaves and exercise equipment.

C. WAYS Presentation by Director Allison Kowieski

WAYS Director Allison Kowieski spoke about WAYS and its services. WAYS has served residents of Wayne and Winfield Townships for the past 42 years. She has been with WAYS for the past 11 years. Services are provided to individuals from age six to adulthood with mental health counseling and tutoring (K-8th grade) in English and Spanish. Residents receive assistance to address issues with anxieties, depression, trauma and anger management. Summer Camp is offered for 10 weeks for children ages from five to ten years old. On July 17th, Wayne Township will host the Township Camp Olympics with township camps from three different counties. A fundraiser for WAYS will take place June 17th at the Carol Stream Wendy's from open to close with a flyer presented at the meeting.

D. Two Appointments to Mental Health Board

Two existing Mental Health Board members stepped down from their positions. One member resigned due to the inability to serve on the Bartlett Village Board and the Mental Health Board. Another member is moving out of state to attend dental school. Katherine Heart of West Chicago and Robert B. Allanson of Bartlett submitted applications after the Board was approved. The Board reviewed their applications.

Trustee Bowen motioned to approve Katherine Heart and Robert B. Allanson for the open Mental Health Board positions.
