

The WTSC is partnering with the DuPage Senior Citizens Council dba Kane Senior Council in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to provide meals to seniors through a temporary meal distribution service. This service may conclude at any time.

If you are 60+ years AND live in DuPage or Kane County you qualify for five frozen meals!!

Call the WTSC at 630-231-7155 to preregister. Multiple persons from one home can qualify but EACH PERSON must preregister.

Pick up your meals at the WTSC; follow the cones and you will be directed where to go. Stay in your car; masks must be worn.

If you do not pre-register you cannot receive meals. If you already receive meals through this organization, you do not qualify.
