We Have FANTASTIC NEWS!!

Wayne Township Pantry and Senior Services has purchased a vehicle that will be used to transport seniors to and from our center! The vehicle is on order and is expected to arrive sometime in May. Juanita Martinez, Director of General Assistance, was able to acquire a grant that covered the entire purchase price of this vehicle for the Senior Center. We will begin with providing rides to and from our center for our members. Once we perfect the schedules, and as the need arises, we plan to make trips to grocery stores and eventually add on trips to Supercenters such as Walmart. 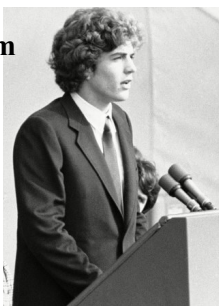

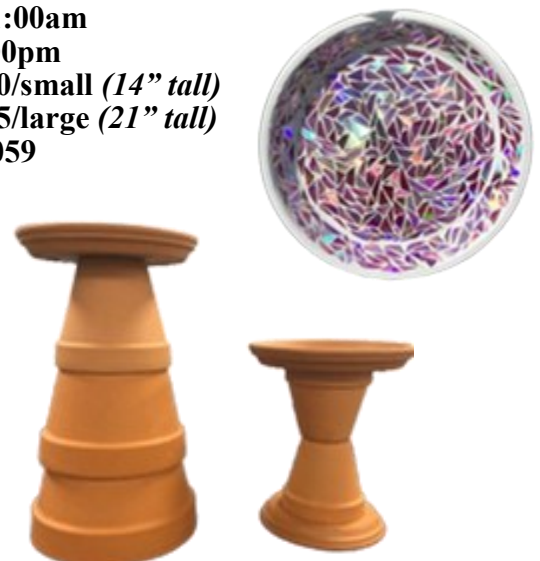
