NEW SC VAN SERVICE PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND INFORMATION



- You must call 48 hours in advance to schedule
- You can schedule up to 2 weeks out
- There is a limit of 3 days per week
- Availability is not guaranteed
- Rides to and from Wayne Township Senior Center ONLY
- You must purchase a punch card prior to scheduling rides; \$30 for 10 one-way rides
- Punch card will remain with the SC staff
- You cannot share your punch card
- Un-used rides are non-refundable
- One punch for each way
- \$3 each way for In-Township Members
- \$3 each way for Out-of-Township Members that live within 2 miles of the Township Boundaries (Windsor Park, Victory Center, etc.)
- Availability 9am-3pm, subject to change according to events/trips **see calendar**
- Unexpected, non-scheduled, “needed ride **HOME**” will cost \$5 cash (no punch card)
