Hello Members!

It's the Most Wonderful Time of the Year! We are so happy to be able to enjoy the holiday season with all of you this year. The "Wish Ornaments" are on the tree and waiting for one of you to take and experience the gift of giving to those less fortunate. New this year for the "Wish Ornaments"... you MUST provide a gift receipt with your purchase as stores are implementing tougher return/exchange policies. All gifts must be wrapped and dropped off before December 12th. Our Senior Center Christmas Party is fast approaching with 245 people already signed up! For those of you who never attended our Christmas Party, please sign up. We will have around 25 raffle baskets and a 50/50 raffle. This is one of our most memorable events of the year and we love celebrating this wonderful holiday with our members.

I want to brag a bit about our wonderful volunteers. Our "Cards for Soldiers" group makes over 40 beautiful, heartfelt cards each month. Members have sewed stockings and created 480 ornaments to go in the stockings which are sent overseas for men and women in harms way. Our Senior Center managed to donate 650 lbs. of needed items for our Soldier Collection... HOLY COW! We also donated 7.18 lbs. of pop tabs to the Ronald McDonald House. These donations keep 172 families together and close to the care they need.

Our "Newspaper Shredding" group shredded 165 bags of newspaper in 12 months, an increase from last year. The shredded newspaper is needed for the puppies and kittens at Anderson Animal Shelter.

Our "Fleece Blanket" group made a ton of blankets which were given to the Animal Welfare group, the Midwest Shelter for Homeless Veterans, Phil's Friends in Roselle, Maryville Academy in Bartlett, Kentucky tornado victims, Ukrainian families, and more. Flannel items were made at home by our volunteers for infants in the NICU at Central DuPage Hospital as well. And if that wasn't enough, even more blankets were donated to Wayne Township Seniors and families signed up through our General Assistance. WOW!

Our "Happy Hatters" group, which is in its 11th year, knits/crochets over 1,000 hats a year for cancer patients, and have made 11,550 hats total - truly SPECTACULAR! Most hats are donated to the Central DuPage Cancer Center as well as to St. Jude and Phil's Friends.

Now... to brag about ALL of you who participated in our Bears and Thanksgiving Day Football Fundraisers...Thank You! You helped us raise \$1,900 for Seniors. AMAZING! This goes to show that when we all come together for a good cause WE MAKE A DIFFERENCE! We are so proud to be a part of such a wonderful group of people and we appreciate how giving, caring, and self-less all of you are.






